RCIS apprentices earn an Associate Degree in Agriculture Business through Northeast Iowa Community College. Tuition is covered. Apprentices are also considered full-time employees and are paid as such. Apprentices receive full benefits and are guaranteed a position upon program completion. Apprentice roles within RCIS include: Claims, Underwriting Services, Sales & Marketing, IT and Finance.

Apprentices who successfully complete the two-year program...

- 1. Work** in a paid, benefits-eligible full-time position at RCIS
- 2. Earn** a tuition-free Associate Degree in Agriculture Business online through Northeast Iowa Community College
- 3. Transition** to a full-time position at RCIS
- 4. Receive** a Department of Labor Certificate of Apprenticeship
- 5. Possess** credentials and skills for today's marketplace.¹
